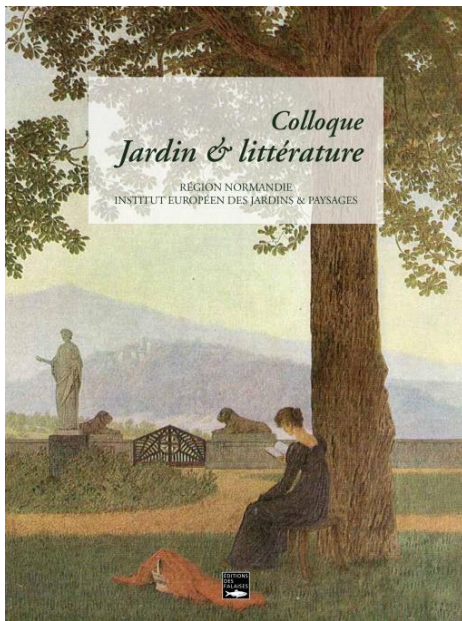

Over the centuries, Normandy's landscape has been shaped, for part, by its occupation by a great diversity of gardens [...]. Whilst the region is characterised by these quite singular landscapes, it is equally so by intangible forms of heritage. Indeed, Normandy has long since been a source of literary inspiration and a land of writing. The 'Jardin & littérature' (Garden & Literature) colloquium held from the 9th to 12th of May 2019 in Caen explored the multifarious, prolific, sometimes symbiotic and always singular links that are forged between landscape art and gardening, and poetic creation and imagination in literary works. The present publication reunites the various interventions during this colloquium. Boasting a wealth of illustrations, it opens the gates of writers' gardens, in Normandy and in Europe, offering you a journey through written works, independently of their generic category, where the poetry inherent to gardens plays a fundamental role.
